



Protocols in M / V Fun Azul

Reception:

- The use of face masks will be mandatory at all times
- Groups of 3 passengers will be formed, they will go one by one to be inspected for sanitation keeping their healthy distance,
- Sanitizing footwear using the sanitizing mat, taking their temperature and sanitizing their hands. This procedure will be carried out by Guide 1.
- Customers will proceed to board the ship and will be driven to their assigned cabin. You will wait for your luggage to finish settling in. Guide 2 will take over it
- Preparation of diving equipment, at the end of addressing all customers. In groups of 3 people they will assemble their equipment at the assigned dive station. Activity supervised by Guide 3
- At the end of the reception, installation and preparation of the equipment, the general orientation of Fun azul will be given, including sanitation procedures during the trip.
- This sanitation will be done 3 times a day covering 5 areas
- Crew area
- Cabin area
- Diving area
- Dining, rest and bridge area
- Sunbathing area
- Each area will be sanitized by the corresponding personnel and supervised daily.
- The program will be done as usual and you will be informed of the activities to be carried out the next day, at the end of the dinner.



Onboard Measurements:

- The temperature of employees and customers will be taken twice a day
- The use of face masks will be mandatory in public areas
- Food will be handled only by assigned personnel
- Anti-bacterial gel, hand soap, as well as paper towels will be available in public spaces, which will be mandatory.
- The buffet mode will change to individual dishes.
- The capacity of the boat will be reduced in compliance with health regulations.

Previous Recommendations

- Do not wear Jewelry, Watches, Bracelets, etc.
- Avoid coughing, sneezing and, if necessary, cover yourself with your elbow or a folded handkerchief
- Don't touch your face, mouth, nose, or eyes
- Do not perform the activity if you have symptoms similar to covid-19
- Personal items should not be shared
- Do not greet with a kiss, hand or hug
- Wash your hands frequently, for at least 20 seconds
- Use Gel with at least 70% of alcohol
